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Minutes of Steering Sub Committee of SLBC for the 101st SLBC meetings held on 22.12.2020 (Tuesday) at 11.30 AM through VC mode.

A meeting of Steering Sub Committee was held on 22.12.2020 at 11.30 AM through virtual mode to deliberate on agenda for 101st SLBC meeting for the Quarter ended 30.09.2020 and to share suggestions and proposals from different stakeholders to finalize a compact agenda.

Sh. Arun Agarwal, General Manager, Punjab National Bank, presided the meeting and the meeting was attended by Ms. Anita Patnaik, GM, FIDD, Reserve Bank of India, Sh. BMK Singh, AGM (FIDD) RBI, Sh. Manoj Kumar, Dy. Secretary Finance-V, GNCTD, Sh. Vikas Bhatt, Dy. General Manager from NABARD, SBI, PNB, ICICI, Bank of Baroda, Canara Bank, Yes Bank, Indian Bank, PFRDA, Bank of India, HDFC Bank and Axis Bank, Union Bank of India, Central Bank of India.

At the outset, Shri Arun Agarwal, General Manager, PNB, Delhi welcomed the participants and invited the participants for any suggestion/addition to the Agenda Items so that the SLBC meeting can be more productive and result oriented.

Sh. Mukesh Sethi, Dy. General Manager & Functional Head, SLBC deliberated the agenda items. The following points emerged for implementation & compliance in the SLBC Meeting as furnished below.

- (1) Sh. Manoj Kumar- Dy. Secretary-Finance suggested that PM SVANidhi Scheme Agenda be included in SLBC meeting for review of progress made under the scheme.
- (2) Ms. Anita Patnaik, GM, FIDD suggested that once the representative of the Revenue Department of GNCTD is nominated on the Task Force, the persisting Action Points should be dropped from the SLBC Agenda.
- (3) Ms. Anita Patnaik suggested that EC-MSME Data submitted to RBI is for 32 Banks, but in SLBC Agenda data of 43 banks are included. From next Quarter the data of 32 Banks be compiled separately, so that the data furnished to RBI for EC-MSME and for SLBC be reconciled.
- (4) CGSSD- Banks with NIL data be asked about the reason for NIL performance.
- (5) GM, FIDD pointed that CD ratio of North East and South East districts were different as submitted by SLBC and LDMs. SLBC to ascertain the reason for the difference. She advised to ensure that there should not be divergence between data furnished by LDMs to RBI and data furnished by SLBC since the data source was same.
- (6) GM, FIDD, RBI advised to ascertain the reason for fall in Rural CD ratio.
- (7) RuPaycard be issued to all PMJDY accounts.
- (8) Renewal of PMJJBY where the annual premium is Rs.330/-, the banks should be sensitized to check that policies should not be discontinued for the reason of non-renewal due to insufficiency of balance in the account. The account holder be informed well in advance to keep sufficient balance in the account.
- (9) The number of FLC camps are less than the targets. The agenda be placed in the SLBC. If it is not possible to organize camps in physical mode then the same may be organized through virtual/digital mode, google-meet etc.



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- (10) GM, FIDD, RBI advised to ascertain the reasons for low performance by 9 Banks having less than 10% priority sector advances.
- (11) The digitization data of New Delhi District – the data submitted by LDM-New Delhi and SLBC should be reconciled.
- (12) PM SVANidhi data be submitted by the banks promptly, Sh. Manoj Kumar advised to escalate the matter of non-submission of data to Head Office of Concerned Bank.
- (13) The Operative KCC data has huge variation from the previous year's data- the banks be advised to give due attention to the integrity of data while uploading on SLBC Portal.
- (14) Standardized system of Data Flow- Member banks are not uploading the data on SLBC portal directly from their CBS/MIS without manual intervention. The same should be ensured.
- (15) The LDM Shahdara has not conducted DCC/DLRC meetings for June/Sept Quarter. The LDMs who have not conducted DCC/DLRC meetings for Sept-2020 Quarter (South, South East & South West) should be directed to hold the same immediately.
- (16) GM, FIDD, RBI advised to include Action Plan for the Milestones of NSFI to be achieved in 2019-24. The status Note should be placed after updation in every Quarter.

With this the meeting was concluded with vote of thanks.
